Albioma Announces the Acquisition of a 26 MW Solar PV Portfolio in Mainland France

Albioma announces the acquisition of a solar photovoltaic (PV) portfolio in mainland France, with a total installed capacity of approximately 26 MW. This transaction increases the capacity of Albioma Solaire France's solar PV fleet to 77 MWp, up from 52.4 MWp previously.

Comprising rooftop solar installations and solar carports, the portfolio is primarily located in Southern France, with additional assets in the northern and eastern regions of the country. The acquisition strengthens Albioma's position in a business that lies at the heart of the Group's strategy, while expanding its geographical footprint through a portfolio of high-quality operational assets.

The portfolio is being acquired from Valeco, a French renewable energy producer and a subsidiary of the EnBW Group since 2019.

Julien Gauthier, Chief Executive Officer of Albioma, commented: *"This acquisition demonstrates Albioma's ability to continue expanding its solar business. I would like to thank all the teams involved in making this transaction a success. It reflects our ambition to contribute, through our renewable energy activities, to the development of competitive, locally produced energy, in line with our sustainable development commitments as set out in our CSR roadmap."*
